

ICCPM and GAPPS COMPLEX PROJECT MANAGER COMPETENCY STANDARDS REVIEW



Highlights from the joint ICCPM and GAPPS event held in Sydney on the 15th February 2018.

The Complex Project Manager Competency Standards have been developed to **outline and define the project management paradigm (mindset), behaviours and knowledge** as well as the **special attributes** required to operate effectively within the complex project environment.

The purpose of these standards and mappings is to provide the project management community, as associations, education providers, organisations and government with a summary view of the areas under each topic that are considered to be universal.

The review process is scheduled to occur over a 12 month period with participants and experts internationally. The purpose of the review is to consider:

1. Relevance of the current contents of the competency standards.
2. Generally consider competencies required to lead complex projects and requirement of leadership to succeed.

The first review workshop was held in Sydney, Australia with a passionate group of project practitioners and academics.

Leadership was topical on the evening, with participants discussing the importance and significance of strong leadership to create innovative and modern organisations that promote flexible interactions and foster nurturing relationships.

Key themes that arose regarding the revision of the competency standards included:

1. The standards should be shorter / more concise.
2. They should address leadership rather than management.
3. They should be capable of application at a number of levels from team member to Project Leader (Director)
4. They should be applicable and relevant to all project types across industry sectors
