**Note:** ICCPM courses follow a thematic curriculum and pedagogical design. Different courses address different aspects of the CPL units of competency and to varying degrees. There is no one size-fits-all and this competency mapping chart should be read in conjunction with the applicable course descriptions.

The key below serves as a guide to understand the mapping of CPL Units of Competency to the various courses. The colour of the 'ticks' is an indication of the extent to which the CPL Unit of Competency is covered in the course curriculum /subject matter.

Determining factors include 1) volume of learning based on course duration, and 2) the thematic focus of the course. These factors limit the extent to which the subject matter can be addressed but the 'tick' indicates that the content is still within the respective Unit of Competency.

Additionally, there is not necessarily an equivalency between the same colour ticks across courses as some courses target different aspects of the same Unit of Competency.

Key	
Comprehensive	This level offers the most extensive coverage.
Moderate	This level provides a solid amount of coverage, addressing many key aspects but with some limitations.
Basic	This level offers minimal coverage, covering only basic aspects.
Not Applicable	This level indicates no coverage is provided.
